### ***Annual Club Picnic and Summer Pull***

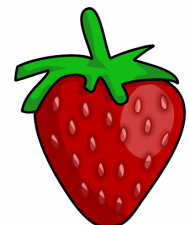

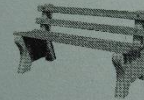
